Whereas it has pleased Almighty God to call to His Mercy our late Sovereign Lady Queen Elizabeth the Second of Blessed and Glorious Memory, by whose Decease the Crown is solely and rightfully come to The Prince Charles Philip Arthur George: I, Alison Mary Blake CMG, Governor of the Falkland Islands do now hereby with one voice and Consent of Tongue and Heart publish and proclaim that The Prince Charles Philip Arthur George is now, by the Death of our late Sovereign of Happy Memory, become our only lawful and rightful Liege Lord Charles the Third, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of His other Realms and Territories, King, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith, to whom we do acknowledge all Faith and Obedience with humble Affection; beseeching God by whom

Kings and Queens do reign to bless His Majesty with long and happy Years to reign over us.

Given at Government House, in the City of Stanley, Falkland Islands this eleventh day of September in the year of Our Lord two thousand and twenty two.

Falkland Islands Constitution
section 38

**Proclamation to provide for sitting of
the Legislative Assembly**

(Proclamation No: 1 of 2022)

1. Section 38 of the Constitution provides that the Governor may appoint a date for sittings of the Legislative Assembly by proclamation published in the *Gazette*.
2. I appoint that at 9am on Friday 16 September 2022 a sitting of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at the Court and Assembly Chamber, Town Hall, Stanley.

No. 88 12 September 2022

Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance 1977
section 72

Appointment of additional public holiday

1. Section 72(3) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance 1977 provides that the Governor may by notice in the *Gazette* appoint any other day to be a public holiday.
2. In accordance with my powers under section 72(3) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance 1977, to mark the State Funeral of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, I appoint Monday 19 September 2022 to be a public holiday.
