DIRECTION

Provision of RFFS at Uncertificated Aerodromes

This Direction is issued to **Aviation Services**, **Falkland Islands Government** in accordance with Article 156 (5) of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013 and specifies the rescue and fire fighting services that are to be made available at all uncertificated aerodromes ordinarily used for FIGAS operations.

This Direction is issued with the following conditions: kland Islands Civil Aviation Falkland viation Falkland Islands Civil Aviation Falkland Islands Civil A

- Aviation Provision of RFFS at Uncertificated Camp Aerodromes which will be reviewed and amended from time to time.
- Avia2. Appendix A to the Direction for the Provision of RFFS at uncertificated aerodromes and Island specifies the detail of rescue and fire fighting services that must be made available at a uncertificated aerodromes ordinarily used for FIGAS operations.
- Records demonstrating compliance with this Direction must be maintained by the Ikland Aviation Accountable Manager, Aviation Services or his designated officer, and must be made a label Aviation Services by the Governor.
- The Accountable Manager, Aviation Services shall comply with any request by any vial alkland Island person authorised by the Governor for a practical demonstration or test to verify alkland compliance with this Direction. Falkland Islands Civil Aviation Falkland Islands Civil
- The Accountable Manager, Aviation Services is to notify the Civil Aviation Department as soon as reasonably practicable if any element of this Direction cannot be complied alkland Island with. Aviation Falkland Islands Civil Aviation Falkland

This Direction shall have effect from 01 April 2020 until it is varied, suspended or revoked.
