**Title: Changes to 'W' licence - fishing season - 2022**

**Date: 7<sup>th</sup> December 2021**

### **1. Background:**


- 1.1. Historically the fishing period for the 'W' licence has been for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January to the 31<sup>st</sup> December.
- 1.2. Target species for this licence type are Southern Blue Whiting (*Micromesistius australis*), Hoki (*Macruronus magellanicus*), Red cod (*Salilota australis*), Kingclip (*Genypterus blacodes*) and Rock cod (*Patagonotothen ramsayi*
- 1.3. The Falkland Islands Government commissioned an independent review of the Finfish fishery and MacAlister Elliot & Partners (MEP 2020) were appointed to undertake this work. The focus of the review was to consider moving finfish allocations from a system of Total Allowable Effort (TAE) to a system of Total Allowable Catch (TAC) or improving the system of TAE.

### **2. Presentation and consultations:**

- 2.1. During the 2021 June and September Fisheries Advisory Committee (FAC), DONR introduced proposals to establish a new management structure for FI finfish trawl licences based on the MEP review.
- 2.2. This new system uses ICES stock assessment modelling to determine the TAC on a stock by stock basis. These TACs are converted into TAE (Vessel Units) to ensure operational management on a TAE basis can continue. Spatial and temporal management tools were also reviewed and amended as part of this process.
- 2.3. Presentations were made by Senior Stock Assessment Scientist – Dr Andreas Winter to both Fisheries Advisory Committee meetings regarding Licensing Advice and Management Proposals for 2022.
- 2.4. Please also refer to Licensing Advice 2022 for more detailed information
- 2.5. Various individual meetings were held by DONR with stakeholders on a company by company basis, as requested, to discuss possible impacts of introducing the changes.

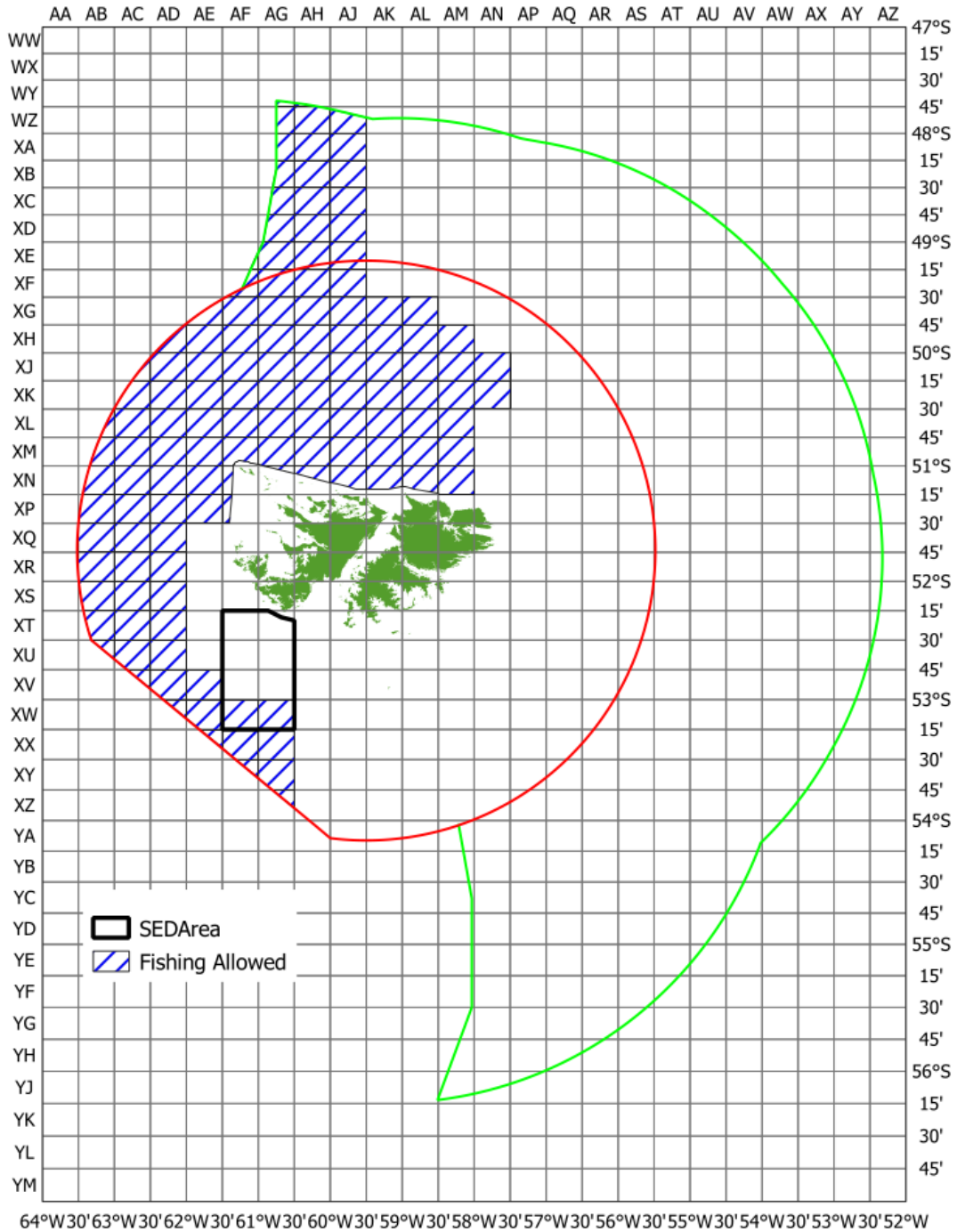
**3. Recommendation:**

- 3.1. To change the fishing season to be open from the 1<sup>st</sup> January to the 31<sup>st</sup> March and then from the 1<sup>st</sup> October to the 31<sup>st</sup> December.
- 3.2. The implementation of this fishing period should avoid by-catch of species not authorised until this licence type.
- 3.3. To decrease the vessel units available for fishing companies with 'W' ITQ, in line with the Catch Entitlement levels approved for 2022 Licensing Advice.

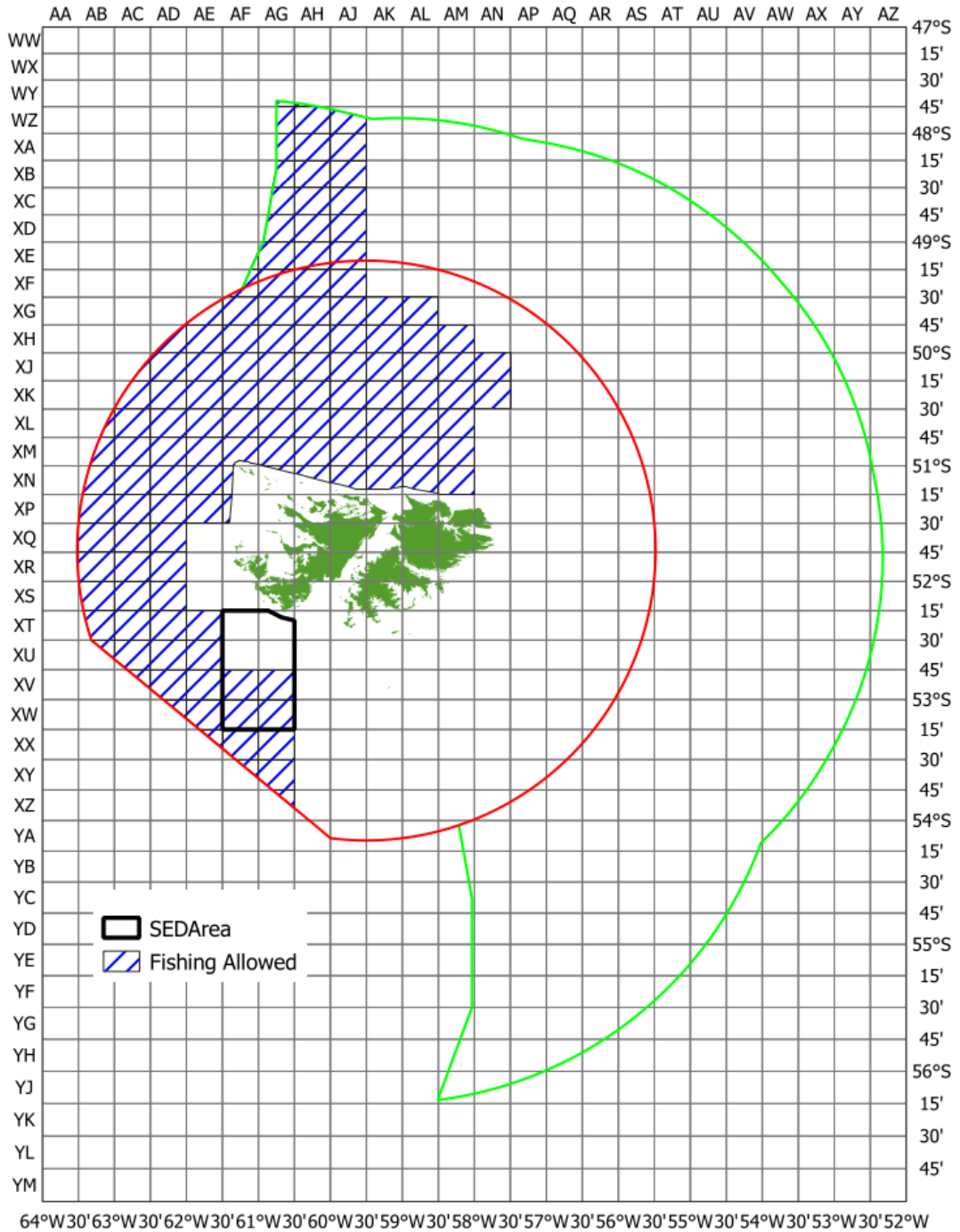

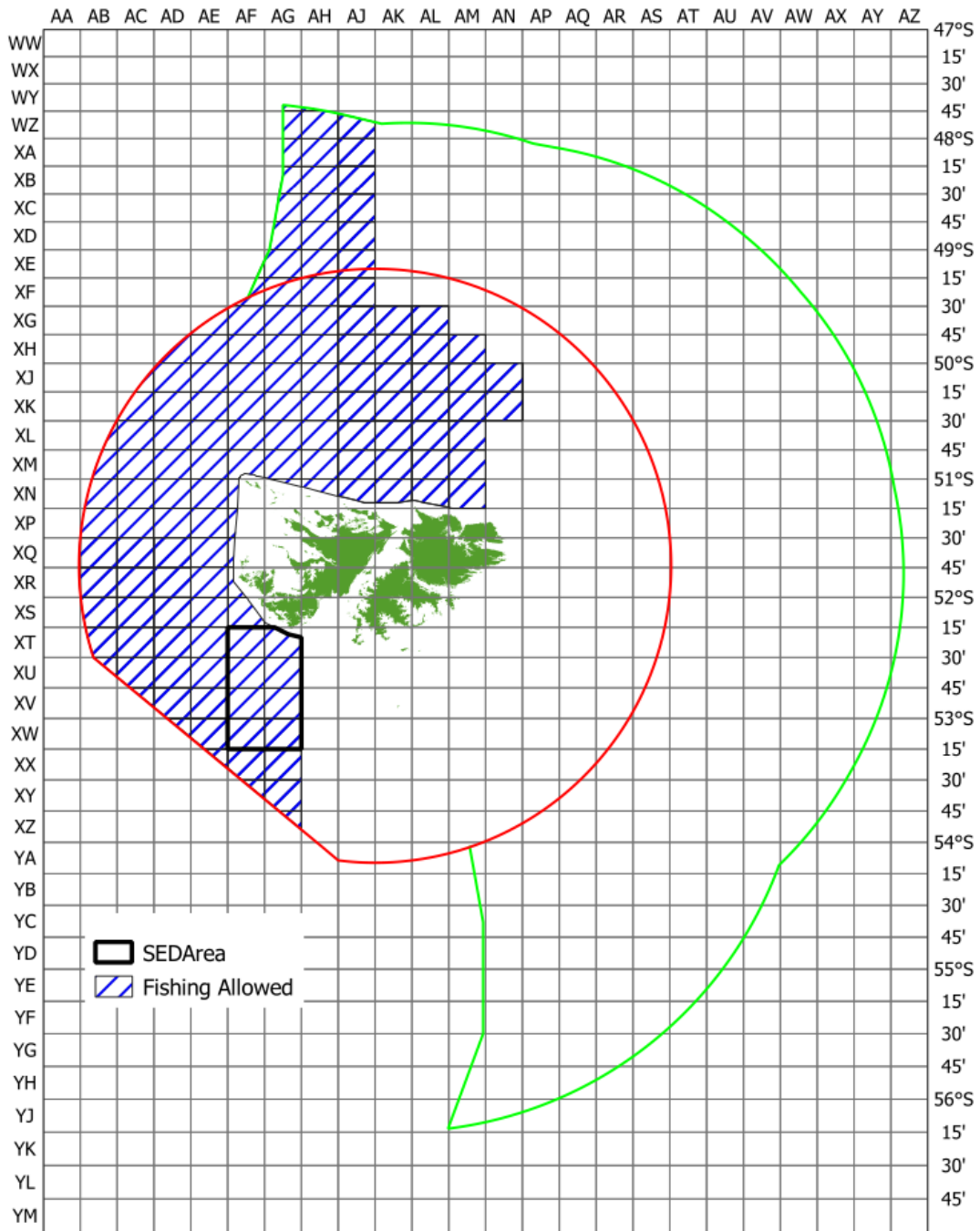
### Falkland Islands Conservation Zones Valid Fishing Areas: Licence Category W With Hake Restriction 01-Oct to 16-Oct
