Job Purpose

This role is charged with delivering and enabling digital excellence across the Falkland Islands Government. The Software and Architecture Development Officer will be responsible for the technical design and development of solutions, taking into account the existing and future business needs of the organisation.

Key Functions

- Responsible for developing databases and software applications to deliver business efficiency for the Falkland Islands Government. Coordinating with the FIG IT provider to ensure efficient working. This includes developing systems in conjunction with key stakeholders and Government departments.
- To increase the efficiency of FIG databases developing systems for user/applicant input via online portals. Ensuring continuous development through cycles of development, implementing and improving both internal and public facing systems.
- Working with various business areas to understand complex business requirements and to deliver effective solutions that deliver against the business objectives.
- Review of the technology landscape to bring in new ideas, support and encourage innovation. Lead ongoing appraisal of developments in technology and application systems and assess how these can impact our business delivery.
- To produce detailed component specifications and develop through to implementation
- To organise and deliver training in new systems/applications.
- To ensure applications are consistent and corporate in their branding.
- To ensure that all security requirements are embedded and that Data Protection best practice principles are at the core of delivery.
- To work collaboratively with the Chief Information Officer in developing systems and security for FIG applications.
