Overall Purpose of the Role:

To ensure that allocated aircraft maintenance tasks are carried out in a safe and efficient manner in accordance with approved maintenance programmes whilst taking into account safety management systems and health and safety practices.

Key Role Activities:

Undertake, as directed by supervisory staff, the tasks required to ensure the continuous maintenance and serviceability of the five Britten- Norman Islanders operated in the Commercial Air Transport role by FIGAS.

Liaise with the supervisory staff to ensure that tasks initiated by the maintenance program are fully supported and embodied in accordance with standard processes and procedures.

Provide a personal quality control of all work undertaken in accordance with the standard Quality Assurance practice.

Undertake the re-fueling and other duties associated with the safe operation of aircraft re-fueling equipment.

Mentor, coach and assist with any in-house training programs for trainee staff as required.

Provide assistance with maintaining a clean and safe working environment, inside and outside the aircraft hangars, conducive to the best practices of aircraft maintenance in accordance with the requirements of the Health and Safety Requirements.

Be proactive in complying with the requirements of the Falklands Aviation Safety Management System (FASMS) and relevant operating manuals and procedures at all times.

The job description is not an exclusive or exhaustive definition of your duties. You shall undertake such additional or other duties as may reasonably be required by FIG commensurate with your role and grade.

Additional Information:

An Aircraft Fitter is required to have a good working knowledge of the processes and procedures necessary to ensure safety and cleanliness at all times when working on aircraft.

Requirement to work on a shift basis which will include weekends and public holidays and to take part in an out of hours on call for emergency medical flights.
