Overall Purpose of the Role

To provide an efficient radiographic service, including plain film and Computer Tomography (CT) undertaking general and specialised techniques. To provide an efficient ultrasound service within agreed departmental protocols.

- Will involve doing general radiography, computer tomography, theatre and mobile work and ultrasound and assisting with visiting specialist visits
- Follow departmental protocols and use professional judgement as to the requirements of individual cases
- Adhere to recognised codes of practise and responsibilities
- Demonstrate continuous professional development
- Attend relevant meetings to represent the Radiographic Department
- Participate in QA programme
- Participation in on call rota for CT, ultrasound and plain film
- Maintain high standards of cleanliness of imaging department
- Laying out of supplies and room preparation for special procedures
- Report to relevant persons all matters, special problems or requirements
- Maintain stock levels
- Specific Ultrasound Responsibilities
- To undertake ultrasound examinations of the required standard for the Antenatal clinic as necessary and provide a written report
