### OFFSHORE MINERALS

#### Offshore Installations (Automatic Safety Zones) Order 1998

(S. R. & O. No. 21 of 1998)

*Made:* 27 February 1998

*Published:* 6 March 1998

*Coming into force:* 30 March 1998

IN EXERCISE of my powers under section 30(1) of the Offshore Minerals Ordinance 1998<sup>(a)</sup> and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs, I make the following Order—

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Offshore Installations (Automatic Safety Zones) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 30th March 1998.

#### **Automatic safety zone provisions to have effect**

2. Section 30 of the Offshore Minerals Ordinance 1994 shall have effect from the date on which this Order comes into force in accordance with article 1.
